- (4) The recordings must be uploaded to online file storage services or submitted by the multimedia file formats viewable with Windows Media Player 12. The files can be sent by DVD or USB. The links for video streaming sites such as YouTube are not acceptable. Video format for DVD is acceptable.
- (5) Do not directly send the files by email.
- (6) Poor sound or visual quality recordings may not be accepted.
