Nippon Music Foundation ("FOUNDATION") provides the ATA Carnet ("CARNET") to Mr. / Ms. ("RECIPIENT") for the purposes of (1) avoiding Customs Charges, approx. 30-50% (US\$ 2 - 5 million) of the value of goods incl. import taxes, penalties etc., (2) avoiding the seizure of the ("INSTRUMENT"), and (3) facilitating Customs clearance procedure. In this Memorandum, the FOUNDATION and the RECIPIENT hereby agree to the terms and conditions concerning the use of the CARNET.

<ul> <li>(Charges and Penalties)</li> <li>The RECIPIENT is liable for payment to the FOUNDATION of any Customs Charges (incl. import taxes, penalties, regularization fees, etc.) imposed on the FOUNDATION if the RECIPIENT fails to:</li> <li>(1) declare the INSTRUMENT to Customs using the CARNET. (Article 1)</li> <li>(2) obtain the Customs officer's stamp and signature on the CARNET and ensure that correct Item Number is specified. (Article 1)</li> <li>(3) re-export the INSTRUMENT out of the Country and Customs Territories before the 'FINAL DATE FOR RE-EXPORTATION' of the CARNET. (Article 2)</li> <li>(4) re-import the INSTRUMENT into Japan before the 'FINAL DATE FOR DUTY-FREE RE-IMPORTATION' of the CARNET. (Article 3)</li> <li>(5) bring back the INSTRUMENT to Japan before the Validity Date of the CARNET. (Article 4)</li> </ul>	
This Memorandum shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Japan, and each of the parties hereto irrevocably submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Tokyo District Court in Japan.
